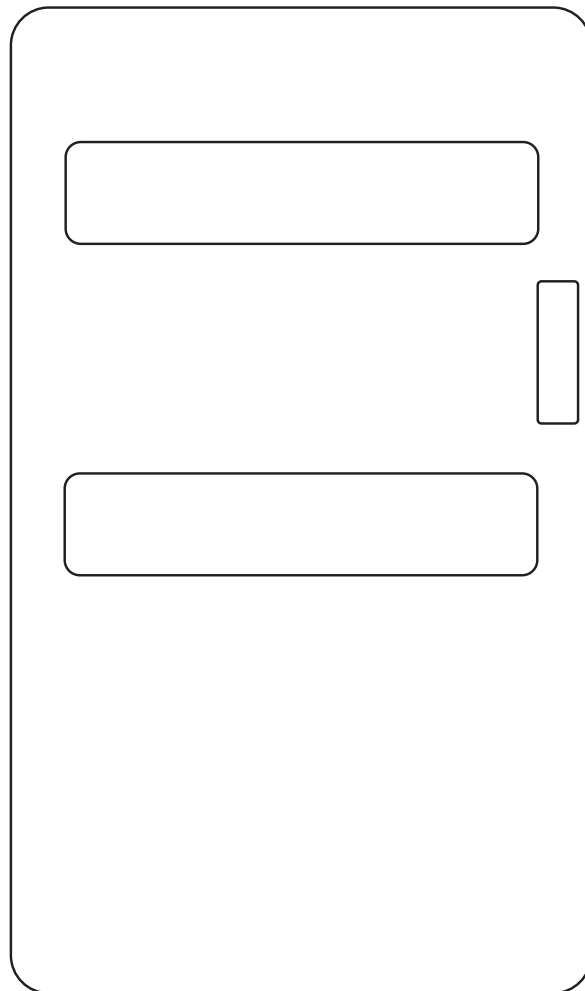

Mirrorstone 160W Electric Towel Rail



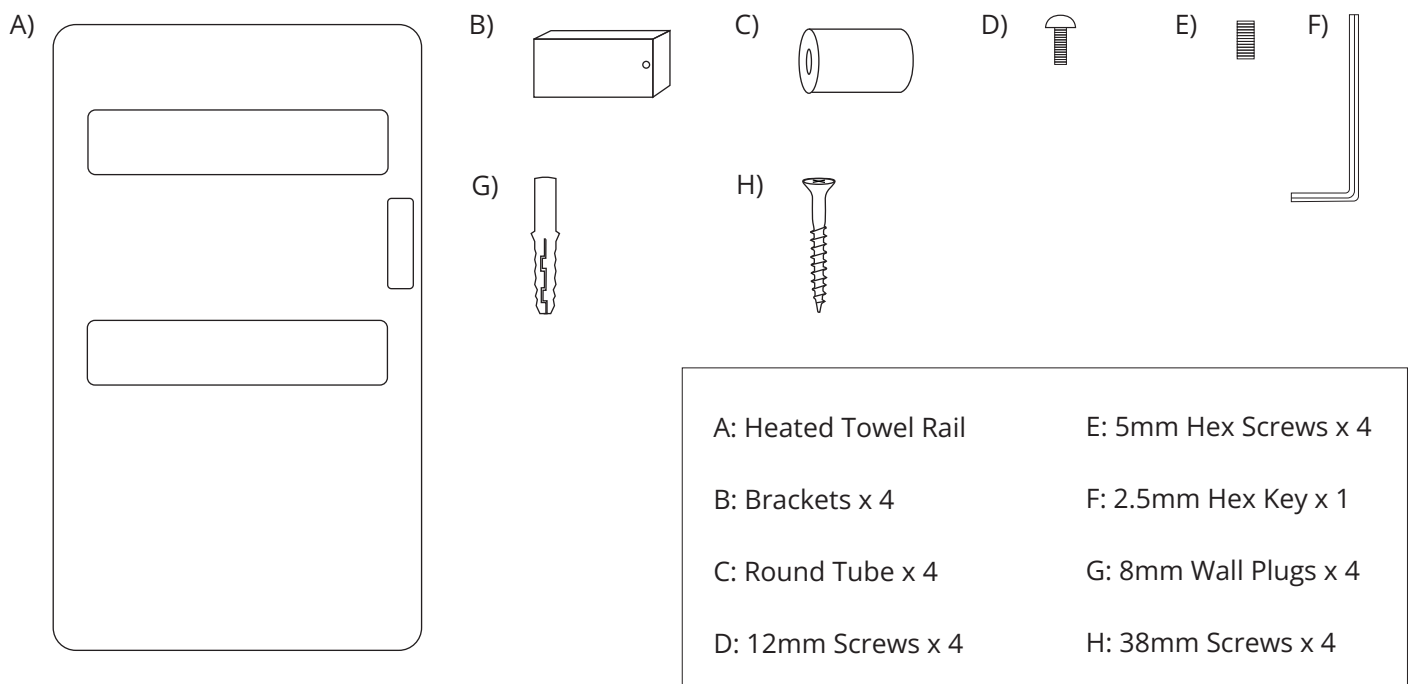
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Thank you for purchasing this Mirrorstone 160W Electric Towel Rail. Before installing and using your towel rail, please read these instructions carefully, and keep this manual safe for future reference.

Please note that any images used in this manual are correct at time of printing, and are subject to change without prior notice.

INCLUDED IN THE BOX



*Please note that parts C, D and E will be inside part B when you receive them. You can use the hex key (F) to unscrew the Hex Screws (E) from the side of the bracket (B) to get the rest of the components out.

INTRODUCTION

The lower levels of IR heat emitted by your 160W Electric Towel Rail warm your towels or bath robes gently, giving you a lovely warm sensation when stepping out of the bath or shower. The three separately controlled heated panels allow for max flexibility, and minimal energy usage.

SAFETY GUIDANCE

- This heater is suitable for use by children aged 8 and above, as well as people with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities. For young children aged under 8 and those who have severely reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, it is strongly advised that this heater be used with supervision.
- Young children should not play with the heater, nor should they engage in any cleaning or maintenance of the heater. This is to be done strictly by adults only.
- The heater should not be sat on or hung off.
- The recommended height for the installation should be where the bottom of the heater sits approximately 600mm off the floor, so that it is out of reach of very young children.
- You must make sure that your electrical supply is switched off at your main switchboard before wiring, installing or servicing your heated towel rail.
- The heated towel rail must be properly grounded during installation.
- All wiring must be in accordance with the electrical safety regulations in whichever country it's being installed in, and should be carried out only by a qualified electrician.
- Never install the heated towel rail in front of, or next to an electrician plug socket, in case a wet towel makes contact with the plug socket and creates the risk of an electric shock.
- We would strongly recommend hardwiring your heated towel rail to avoid any plug sockets being exposed to moisture.
- Never install the towel rail inside a shower, sauna, steam room, or otherwise in any zone 1 space in your bathroom.

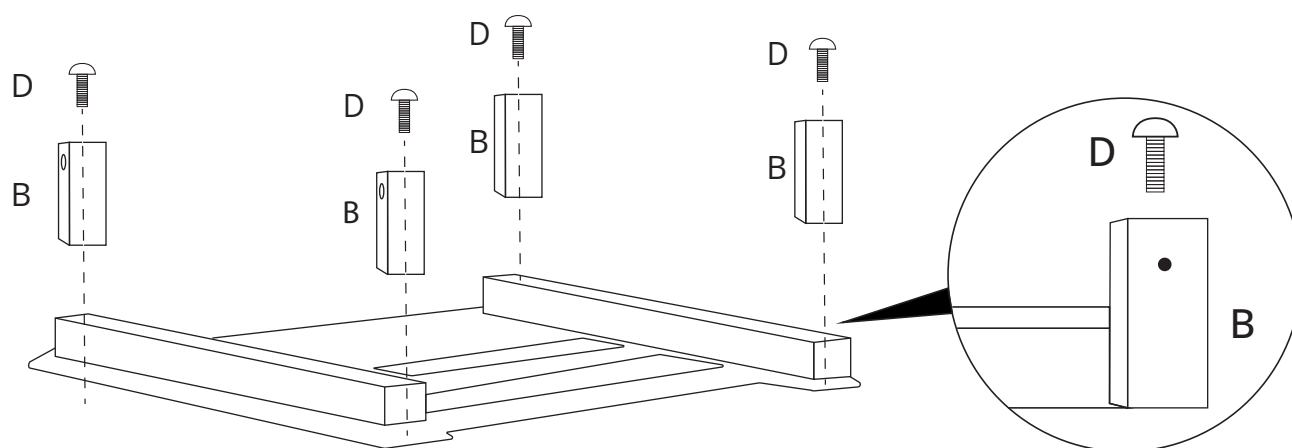
CLEANING GUIDANCE

- Always ensure that the power supply to your heated towel rail is switched off before carrying out any maintenance or cleaning.
- Only use a soft, non-abrasive cloth when cleaning your heated towel rail. Ensure that it is only damp.
- Once the heated towel rail has cooled, you can polish it with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use any abrasive cleaning products or solutions, metal polish, or chlorine based cleaners on any part of the heated towel rail.

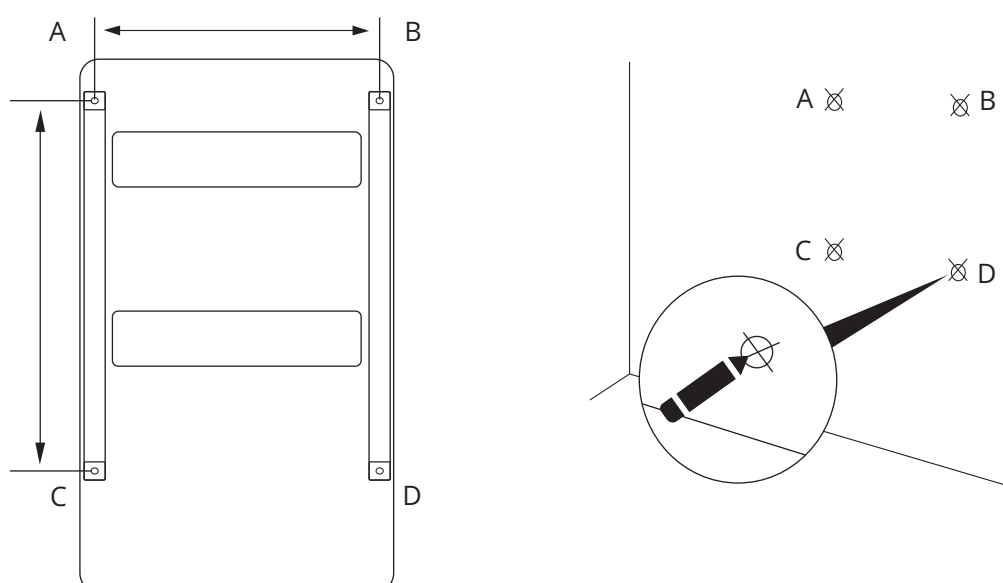
INSTALLATION

This heated towel rail must be installed in accordance with the electrician safety regulations in whichever country it's being installed in, and should be carried out only by a qualified electrician.

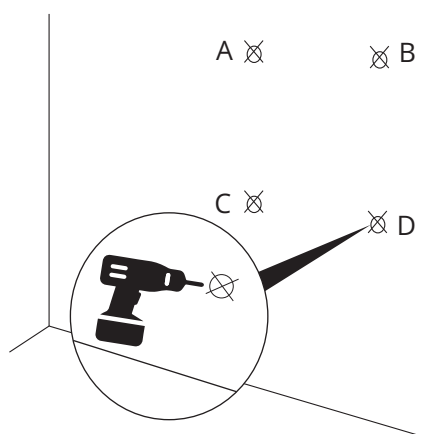
1. Affix brackets (B) to the heated towel rail (A) using 12mm screws (D). Please ensure that the hole for the Hex Screw on the side of the Bracket is facing the outside of the Heated Towel Rail.



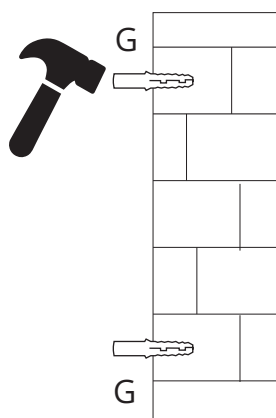
2. Mark out the positions for the brackets on your wall. You can do this by measuring the distances between each hole on the back of the Heated Towel Rail.



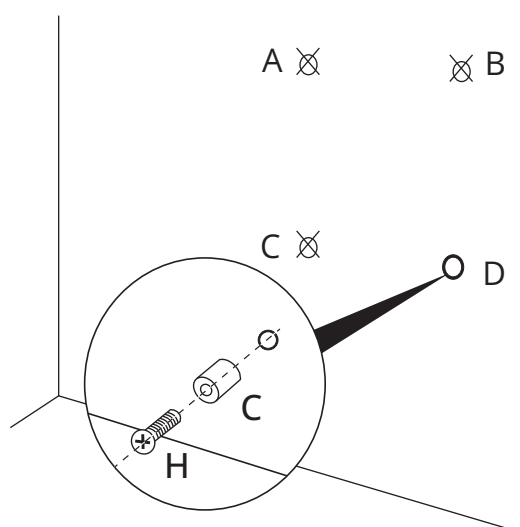
3. Using an 8mm drill bit, drill into the wall where you marked them out in step 2).



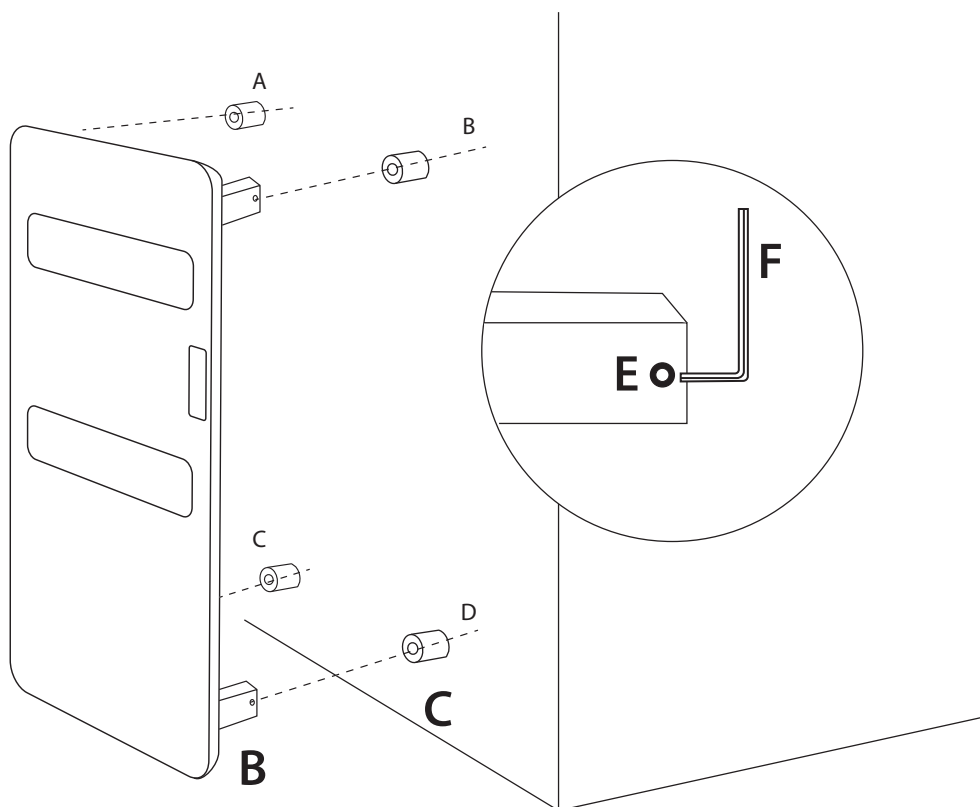
4. Insert the wall plugs into the holes, using a hammer or mallet to lightly tap them all the way in.




5. Use the 38mm Screws (H) to fit the Round Tubes (C) to the wall, by screwing them into the wall plugs until they're tight.



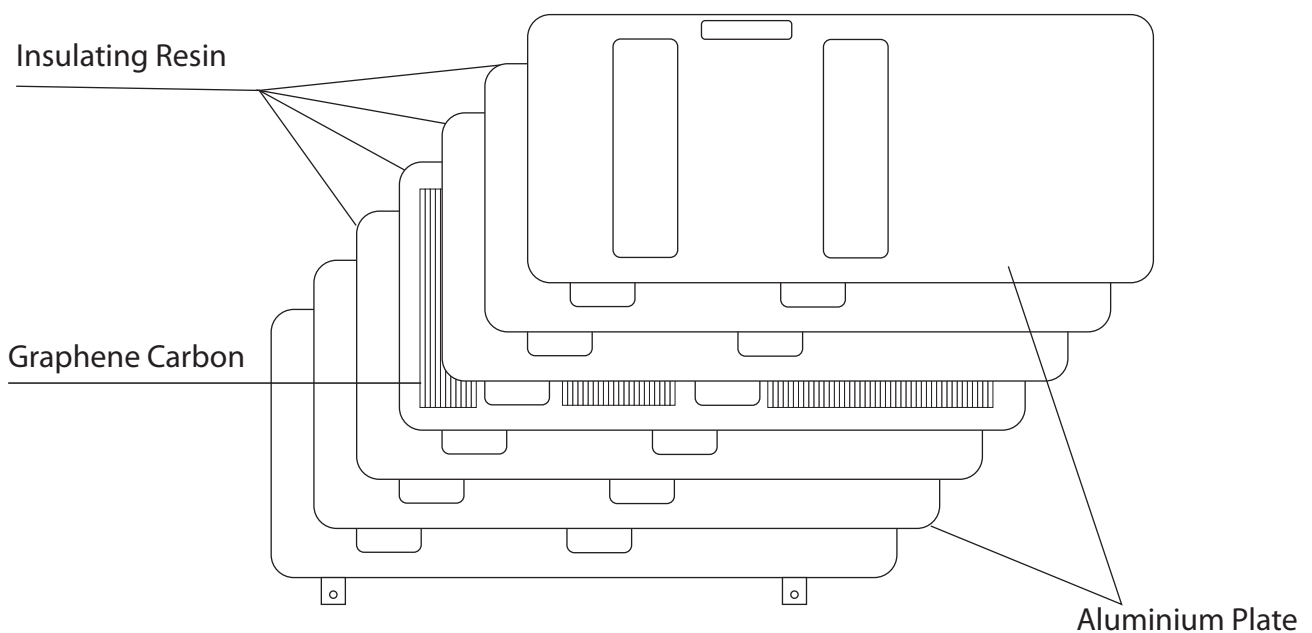
6. Fit the Heated Towel Rail (A) to the wall by placing the Round Tubes (C) into the Brackets (B), and fixing them into place by using the Hex Key (F), and tightening the Hex Screws (E) into the holes in the sides of the Brackets (B).

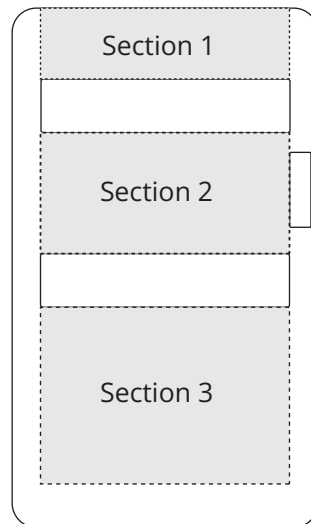
PRODUCT DIAGRAM



USING YOUR HEATED TOWEL RAIL

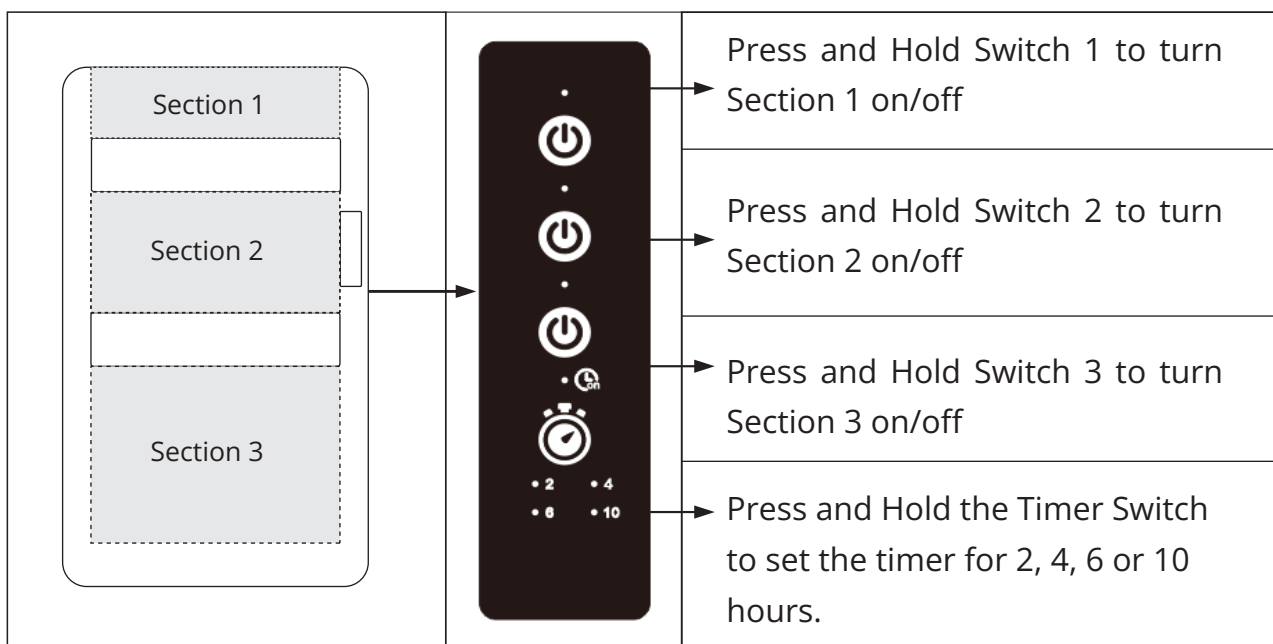
Only once your Heated Towel Rail is installed and connected to a grounded outlet should you power it on.

Your Heated Towel Rail has three heated sections highlighted in the diagram below.



You can control each one individually using the control panel located on the right hand side of the heater as you're looking at it.

There are three power buttons, each corresponding to a different heated section.



WARRANTY
